Project Spotlight

Continuing on from last month's Project Spotlight where we shared some of the Project Power App solution functionality we have delivered, this month we would like to share a solution that is built on the same Power Platform, but provides a fully customised outcome to support a property leasing process.

For many of our customers, choosing an 'off-the-shelf' product to support an established business process sometimes doesn't make sense. Yes it competes with the ICT philosophy of 'custom solutions generate technical debt', but there are occasions when the benefits of a custom solution that is integrated to your organisation's operating system is far more attractive than the change impact and disruption of re-engineering a business process. The Microsoft Power Platform is a great option in this space, it's low code, rapid deployment, highly secure foundation is second to none and has provided many of our customers immediate benefits.

Customer X was seeking to automate its Property Expense Request (PER) process, which currently requires users to capture information about a collection centre alongside financial aspects of the site for review and approval. This data is primarily used to forecast revenue and costs from all leased sites, and to notify users of key information related to approvals, lease and licensing renewals.

We were able to design, configure, and implement the solution on the Microsoft Dataverse and configure a custom model-driven Power App user interface that is supported by a Power BI report set.

The PER Power App provides users a central location to manage Approved Collection Centre's (ACC), Property Expenditure Requests (PER), Leases and Medicare Licenses. The application enables users to enter, edit/change, and seek approval through the PER process in addition to providing data to the analytics tool Power BI for advanced reporting requirements. Complex approval workflows and the integration of the financial model within the application, resulted in a streamlined approval process that can be utilised on mobile devices.

As mentioned earlier, this is one of many solutions the team have designed and delivered on the Microsoft Power Platform, we hope to share more with you in future newsletters.
